- Pursuant to the resolution of the Board of Directors dated 25 May 2021, approving the Master's programme in Cooperation for Rural and Agri-Food Sustainable Development for academic year 2021/2022, with the favourable opinion of the Academic Senate of 11 May 2021;
- Pursuant to Rector's Decree no. 3138/2021 of 15 July 2021, issuing the call for applications for the aforementioned Master's programme;
- Pursuant to Rector's Decree no. 2955/2021 of 8 July 2021, calling for applications for DSU scholarships for academic year 2021/2022;
- Pursuant to the note of the Delegate for development cooperation in the agri-food and environmental fields of 1 September 2021;

HEREBY DECREES

The following financial aid is made available in the form of a partial tuition waiver for the first-level Master's programme in *Cooperation for Rural and Agri-Food Sustainable Development* for academic year 2021/2022, to be granted based on merit ranking for admission to the programme:

- a) **Four grants of € 3,000.00 each** for candidates from particularly poor and developing countries, as listed in the Decree of the Minister of University and Research of 12 February 2021;
- b) **Four grants of € 2,000.00 each** for candidates from other countries, who are currently in particularly poor and developing countries as defined in point a) above for cooperation activities.

Any funds that are not fully disbursed to one of the two categories shall be made available to the other category.

The grants will be awarded in compliance with income requirements as set forth by Rector's Decree no. 2955/2021 of 8 July 2021. The University reserves the right to require evidence of the financial condition of the household for an ex-post assessment.
