- Qualifications will be assessed on 8th July 2024.
The assessment outcome will be posted on the [University website](#), on the programme webpage, before the start date of the interviews.
- Interviews will be held online and will be starting from 18th July 2024 at 09:00 a.m.
The interview schedule – specifying the date and time of the interview for each candidate, as well as the title of his/her research project – will be posted on the [University website](#), on the programme webpage.
The interview can be in Italian or English, according to the candidate's choice. English proficiency will in any case be ascertained.
- Enrolment in the PhD programme is from 9 to 21 August 2024, at 2 p.m. via [Sifa Online Services](#) in accordance with the procedures published on the [University website](#).
- Candidates who are enrolled in another university course for the a.y. 2024/25 have to verify the compatibility with the enrolment in a PhD programme on the webpage [Simultaneous enrolment in two higher education programmes](#).
After the PhD rankings are published and before starting the enrolment procedure, the admitted candidates will have to upload the application for the simultaneous enrolment via the online procedure and attach the required documents (in case of two postgraduate courses: the approval of the PhD Coordinator and the approval of the Director of the Postgraduate School/of the Organizing Committee of the Vocational Master you are enrolled in).
Until the managing bodies have given their approval, a self-certification can be attached regarding the possibility of attending the two programmes at the same time.
