HAVING REGARD TO

Law no. 264 of 02 August 1999 regulating access to university programmes;

HAVING REGARD TO

Ministerial Decree no. 270 of 22 October 2004, "Amendments to the regulations on the educational autonomy of universities" (Modifiche al regolamento recante norme concernenti l'autonomia didattica degli atenei) approved with Decree of the Minister for Universities and Scientific and Technological Research no. 509 of 3 November 1999;

HAVING REGARD TO

The decisions of the responsible academic boards concerning access to university programmes;

DETERMINES

A selection for admission to single cycle degree programmes in Biotecnology (Class L-2) for the 2019/2020 academic year. The selection is set on two sessions taking place in July and September 2019. Each selection contributes to the coverage of a quota of the total available places.

Art. 1 - Admission requirements

The following requirements are necessary to be admitted to the selection:

- be enrolled in the final year of a secondary school, with the prospect of obtaining the qualification in the 2018/2019 scholastic year
- hold an Italian secondary school qualification or equivalent qualification obtained abroad.
- have passed the <u>TOLC-S test provided by CISIA</u> Consorzio Interuniversitario Sistemi Integrati per l'Accesso within the deadlines set in art. 3.

Foreign qualifications are valid if obtained after at least 12 years of schooling and if they allow the admission to University in the country where they have been obtained.

All details on foreign qualifications and access for foreign students to Italian Universities are contained in the annual Ministerial provisions, published on the Ministry website:

http://www.studiare-in-italia.it/studentistranieri/ and reported on the University website in the sections dedicated to international students.

The eligibility of the foreign qualification is in any case assessed by the University having regard to the aforementioned provisions and in application of the bilateral agreements in force.

Art. 2 - Number of places available

The number of places available for enrolment in the first year is determined as follows:

- July session: 50 places
- September session: **200 places**, plus **8 places** reserved for non-European candidates applying for a study visa

Total: 250 places plus 8 places for non-European candidates

Places left vacant in the July sessions will be assigned in the September session.

Art. 3 -Test dates and registration procedure

The TOLC-S test can be taken:

- at Università degli Studi di Milano on 22nd May, 22nd July, 4th, 9th, 10th and 11th September 2019;
- at one of the CISIA test venues on the dates indicated on to the calendar published on the website www.cisiaonline.it.

The test can be taken more than one time, but no more than once in a calendar month. For the purposes of the selection, will be considered valid the outcome of the last TOLC-S, within the deadlines established for each session.

To take part in the selections, candidates must register online:

- a) on the CISIA portal to book the test
- b) on the UNIMI portal to be included in the ranking list.

a) CISIA registration and testing

Registration for the TOLC-S test must be done on CISIA portal - www.cisiaonline.it - by the deadlines set for every testing date and available in the section DATE TOLC.

Using the credentials received after the registration, candidates must login in their personal area and fill in the online form with the required data.

Date and venue of the test are reported on the receipt issued after completing the application.

To register in the test it is necessary to pay to CISIA an admission fee of 30.00 euros via MAV or credit card.

b) Application on the University portal

To enter the ranking list, all candidates must apply on our University portal www.unimi.it, within the deadlines established for each session, following the procedure below:

- 1. Register on the University portal (not required of those already registered on the portal or in possession of university login credentials)
- 2. Access the online application services using their credentials: http://www.unimi.it/hpsifa/ENG/nonProfiledPage_100.html;
- 3. Select the degree program and fill in the form online with their personal data:

At the end of the procedure, a receipt is issued as a proof of the admission application.

The online admission form cannot be amended, nor it can be completed with additional documentations once it has been submitted.

Any applicant who provides false details or lacks requirements will be excluded from the final ranking list.

Art. 4 - Admission exam and assessment criteria of the ranking list

The TOLC-S is an orientation and evaluation test, aimed at ascertaining the aptitude and preparation for studies for access to degree courses, composed by 50 multiple-choice questions divided in the following sections:

- Mathematics 20 questions in 50 minutes
- Logic and problems 10 questions in 20 minutes
- Text Comprehension 10 questions in 20 minutes
- Science 10 questions in 20 minutes

The test includes an English section whose result does not contribute to the calculation of the final score.

The admission exam answers are scored as follows:

- 1 point for each correct answer,
- -0.25 points for each wrong answer,
- 0 points for not given answers.

The ranking list is formulated on the basis of the total score, obtained in the four sections indicated above.

In the event of equal point scores, priority is given to the candidate with the best score in the *Mathematics* test section and, subsequently, in *Text Comprehension*. In the event of further parity, priority is given to the younger candidate.

Candidates who do not achieve an overall score of at least 20 points, equal to 40% of the points available, are excluded from the ranking lists of July.

Those who are not included in the rankings of July can compete in the next session.

Art. 5 - Disabled applicants

Applicants with disabilities must declare their condition and require extra time and/or specific aids for the test during the registration in the TOLC area of the CISIA portal.

They must select Università degli Studi di Milano as test venue and must submit through the CISIA portal suitable certification of status of handicap under law 104/92 or civil invalidity.

Art. 6 - Applicants with SLD

Applicants with a diagnosis of specific learning disabilities (SLD) must declare their condition and require extra time and/or specific aids for the test during the registration in the TOLC area of the CISIA portal.

They must select Università degli Studi di Milano as test venue and must submit through the CISIA portal suitable certification of specific learning disabilities (SLD) under law no. 170/2010, issued by the National Health Service or accredited private center or specialists, together with an ASST conformity document.

The documentation must be issued no more than three years earlier if the applicant was underage at the time of the issuance of the certification.

Art. 7 - Students coming from other programmes or universities, and graduates

Students already enrolled in the degree programme in Biotecnology at the University of Milan are exempt from the admission exam.

Students enrolled in other degree programmes at the University of Milan or another university may be admitted to years subsequent to the first only if they have acquired at least 36 CFU (ECTS) in subjects equivalent to those of the first year of Biotechnology. To be recognised, the exams must be considered valid by the Teaching Commette, in particular Mathematics, Physics, General and Inorganic Chemistry and Organic Chemistry. In the validation request cannot be included credits obtained in English courses. The documents about the academic career must be sent within 1st July 2019, together with a copy of the tax code, to the Didactic Secretariat e-mail biotecnologia.segreteria@unimi.it.

Candidates will be notified of the outcome of the evaluation by e-mail.

Students and graduates who do not fall into the aforementioned categories must sit the test.

Art. 8 - Ranking list publication, enrolment and updating

8.1 Ranking list publication

The ranking lists will be published on the University website, at the following page http://www.unimi.it/hpsifa/ENG/nonProfiledPage_100.html (www.unimi.it - Online services SIFA - Admission Ranking Lists) on the days established for each session (art.9), after 2:00 p.m.

The publication has full notification value. No individual communication is sent to the candidates, who are required to verify the enrolment deadlines, scrollings and all the notices published on the page of the ranking of the degree programme chosen.

In any case, the admission to the degree programme is subordinated to the achievement of a secondary school qualification or equivalent foreign qualification, within the deadlines established for the enrolment.

Non-EU candidates resident abroad, recipients of the reserved places indicated in art. 2, will be placed in separate ranking lists, based on the totale score obtained in the test. These candidates can enroll only if included in the quota of reserved places and if they pass the Italian language test organized by the University. 8.2 Enrolment and updating

Place winners must enrol online within the deadlines established for each session, indicated at art.9, through the online Enrolment service at the page: http://www.unimi.it/hpsifa/ENG/nonProfiledPage_100.html.

Only for the September session will be made an updating of the ranking list.

Winners who do not enrol by the above date and time, tacitly withdraw from the place.

8.3 Applicants with qualifications gained abroad

Applicants with qualifications gained abroad must complete the enrolment delivering the following documentation to the International Students Office - Via Santa Sofia 9/1, Milan - by **31**st **October 2019**:

- Upper secondary school diploma, translated into Italian, legalized by the authorities in the country where the qualification was issued and carrying a Dichiarazione di valore; or statement of validity issued by ENIC_NARIC centres or by diplomatic missions resident in Italy;
- Certificate of enrolment at university with a list of the exams taken, or certificate of
 post-secondary education obtained in a non-university higher education institute if the
 local education system provides less than 12 years of schooling;
- Certificate of academic eligibility if provided for in the country of origin;
- Any other document stating specific requirements of validity of the title (e.g. Aps for the United States titles, A-level for British titles);
- Valid residence permit (only for non-EU citizens).

Verification of the validity of qualifications gained abroad is conducted upon presentation of the official documents (show the original and deposit a photocopy).

Until then, applicants are admitted to the programme conditionally and may be excluded from the ranking list if they prove not to have the necessary qualifications.

Art. 9 - Procedures and deadlines summary

- 3) Pass the TOLC-S test
- 4) Enrol
