CARATTERISTICHE DEL CORSO DI STUDI

Premessa

The Laurea Magistrale in Law and Sustainable Development (LL.M. in Law and Sustainable Development) at the University of Milan is the first European graduate programme that aims at improving the legal skills necessary to better grasp the three interconnected dimensions (economic, social, and environmental) of sustainable development. It offers students an in-depth interdisciplinary academic education to specialize in key issues agreed upon by the International Community within the 2030 Agenda for Sustainable Development "Transforming Our World" and the 17 Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs). Entirely taught in English, the LL.M. provides specialized education and training enabling legal professionals to tackle contemporary economic, social, and environmental challenges through a multidisciplinary, integrated and holistic approach, which is at the very heart of the notion of sustainable development.

Obiettivi formativi generali e specifici

The LL.M. programme trains a new generation of legal specialists able to reconcile social development, environmental goals, and economic growth in the activities of private and public organizations. LL.M. graduates will be able to contribute to fostering favourable conditions for long-term competitiveness, social cohesion, and better environmental protection. At the local, national, and international levels, they will play a role in updating existing legal frameworks, business practices, and social action to the requirements and expectations about what the law can do in the sustainable development realm.

Profilo professionale e sbocchi occupazionali

The LL.M. in Sustainable Development aims at training legal experts, with a comprehensive background in the economic, social and environmental dimensions of sustainable development. Our graduates acquire the necessary skills to elaborate, support and assess sustainable legal and economic policies and strategies both in the public and private sectors.

With regard to the public sector, the Programme aims at training legal experts able to integrate social, economic and environmental concerns in the central and local Public Administration's policies in key areas such as: telecommunication, new technologies, water, sanitation, health, electric power and gas, transportation, infrastructure, agriculture, green public

procurement.

As regards the private sector, the LL.M. Programme aims at training ethically oriented corporate legal experts and economic operators, able to play a key role in monitoring, tracking, aligning and integrating the social and environmental impacts in the business sector, in order to help companies to meet their corporate responsibility and sustainability goals.

Furthermore, the LL.M. Programme aims at training environmental and sustainability managers and consultants and experts in management and audit of Public Administration and private companies.

Struttura del corso

The LL.M. Programme is a two-year Programme (120 ECTS).

In the first year students mandatorily attend seven core courses (60 ECTS): International Law and International Law on Sustainable Development, Economic Geography, Global Constitutional Law, Sociology, Economics, Economic Policy and Social Justice, World Economic History from Growth to Sustainable Development, The Role of Public Administration in Enhancing Equitable and Sustainable Development. These courses ensure that all enrolled students acquire a solid “common basis” to understand the complexity and the interdependencies of sustainable development.

In the second year (60 ECTS), students are required to attend four elective courses among those offered. Elective courses are organised into four streams:

Stream 1: Economic Development

Stream 2: Human Rights and Social Development

Stream 3: Environmental Protection

Stream 4: Rule of Law

Students may choose to specialise in one of the streams or tailor their study plan to their individual preferences.

In order to take the exams of the 2nd year, students must have passed all the exams of the 1st year.

LL.M. IN SUSTAINABLE DEVELOPMENT MAIN FEATURES

- 120 ECTS in 4 semesters.

- Language of instruction: English.

- Four specialization streams: Law, Economics, and Development; Human Rights Law and Social Development; Environmental Law and Policy; Rule of Law.

The LL.M. in Law and Sustainable Development offered by the University of Milan is a Postgraduate/Second Cycle/Master Programme (Laurea Magistrale). Students who are awarded qualification (i.e. completion of the second cycle) hold a 2nd level degree recognized by all the European countries and organizations adhering to the Bologna Process and the European Higher Education Area.

Caratteristiche Tirocinio

Internships and trainings are integral part of the LL.M. Programme. Subject to their practical feasibility and consistency with the study programme, the LL.M. offers preferential access to internships and trainings at local administrations, non-profit and civil society associations (NGOs and charities), international organizations operating in the field of development cooperation, law firms, trade unions, private companies, professional associations, foundations, banks and cooperatives. Internships help students to prepare projects and case studies that can be the starting point for their final thesis.

2 Accesso da altri corsi di laurea

Degree Requirements:

Candidates applying for the LL.M. in Sustainable Development must hold:

- either an Italian first degree (Bachelor) pertaining to classes: L-14 (Scienze dei servizi giuridici), L-33 (Scienze economiche), L-36 (Scienze politiche e delle relazioni internazionali), L-37 (Scienze sociali per la cooperazione, lo sviluppo e la pace), L-16 (Scienze dell'amministrazione e dell'organizzazione), L-18 (Scienze dell'economia e della gestione aziendale).
- or a foreign Degree (180-300-360 ECTS) in Law, Economics, Political Science, International Relations.

Candidates holding Italian and foreign Degrees in other fields will be admitted on a case-by-case evaluation of their curriculum vitae et studiorum and motivation letter. If admitted, they will be mandatorily required to do the suggested preliminary readings, in order to integrate their basic knowledge in subjects taught before the beginning of the Programme.

Language ability:

Applicants whose native language is not English or who do not hold a Degree fully taught in English, must demonstrate English language proficiency by passing one of the following:

IELTS: we require a IELTS minimum overall score of 7.0, with a minimum of 6.5 in each of the reading, writing, listening and speaking components.

TOEFL: if the IELTS is not available, students may take the TOEFL test. We require a minimum overall score of 100, with a minimum of 25 in each of the reading, writing, listening and speaking components.

ESPERIENZA DI STUDIO ALL'ESTERO NELL'AMBITO DEL PERCORSO FORMATIVO

QUEEN MARY UNIVERSITY OF LONDON: Following the successful completion of the first year of the LL.M. in Sustainable Development, students may be granted admission to one of the LL.M. programmes offered by Queen Mary University of London (QMUL). Upon successful completion of the two programmes, students will be awarded both the UNIMI and the QMUL Master's degrees.

INSTITUTO INTERNACIONAL DE SOCIOLOGÍA JURÍDICA DE OÑATI – UNIVERSIDAD DEL PAÍS VASCO: after attending the first year of the LL.M. in Sustainable Development, students may be granted admission to the one-year International Master in Sociology of Law of Insituto Internacional de Sociología Jurídica de Oñati – Universidad del País Vasco. Students succesfully completing their 'Dual Degree Programme' studies will obtain the two degrees, issued respectively by the two institutions.

Pre-application:

Italian and foreign students are strongly recommended to submit their pre-application within 30 April 2019 at llm@unimi.it (please follow instructions at: www.llmsd.unimi.it).

Non-EU citizens resident abroad, who do not have an Italian residence permit, must submit a pre-application request to the Italian diplomatic representation in their country of residence. The competent Italian Embassy/Consulate is the authority responsible for accepting their pre-applications and checking if they meet the requirements for the Study Visa (generally from April to July).

All candidates are required to upload the following documents:

- Degree certificate and official transcripts, issued by the Universities attended, recording exams taken, grades and credits
- Passport - personal data: copy of the page with personal details
- Letter of motivation (describing applicant's background, primary area of interest, practical or academic experience in the area, and how the LL.M. will be used after graduation).
- Curriculum vitae et studiorum
- Two (optional) letters of recommendation from recommenders who can best evaluate the applicant's capacity to attend the LL.M. Programme

University application procedure for the academic year 2019-2020 is open from 1 March 2019 to 13 September 2019.

Modalità della prova

The Didactic Board (Collegio didattico) evaluates language and personal competencies of the candidates holding a suitable first-cycle degree. Candidates holding a postgraduate degree in other fields may also be considered for admission.

Applicants whose native language is not English or do not hold a Degree issued upon the completion of an academic programme fully taught in English, must demonstrate proficiency in English by providing one of the following international certifications:

- IELTS: minimum overall score of 6.5, with a minimum of 6.5 in each of the reading, writing, listening, and speaking components.
- TOEFL: minimum overall score of 94, with a minimum of 23 in each of the reading, writing, listening, and speaking components.

The knowledge and personal skills of the candidate who satisfies the conditions set out above are assessed by the Didactic Board, based on the academic background and CV of the candidate.

The Didactic Board may admit candidates on condition that they bridge their gaps by carrying out preliminary and compulsory readings indicated by the teachers holding compulsory courses of the first year and attending the introductory courses.
