STRUCTURE OF THE ABSTRACT

Abstracts can be structured and must include:

INTRODUCTION

a brief introduction stating the purpose of the investigation and its relevance; *METHODS*

a description of the methodology used;

RESULTS

to be supported by statistical or other evidence to show their validity; *CONCLUSIONS*

The body of the abstract must not exceed 2300 characters, spaces included.

GENERAL INFORMATION

Deadline for receipt: Abstracts should be submitted by **June 30th 2017 12 am local time** Confirmation of receipt: Receipt of the abstract will be acknowledged by e-mail immediately after submission.

Notification of acceptance or rejection: Authors will be notified of acceptance or rejection within **July 15th 2017**.

Registration: The presenting author of each abstract must register for the congress Poster Size: 100 x 70 cm all abstract, comprise the abstracts selected for oral presentation during the scientific session, should be presented also as poster.


